

BACKGROUND:

The latch triggers on the nacelle FWD cowling doors have on some aircraft been trimmed to make the latch fit the form of the cowling surface. This could cause abnormal abrasion on the

triggers, and might cause the latches to come unlocked, and result

in cowling door opening during flight.
