BACKGROUND:

Saab 91B and Saab 91C airplanes were originally delivered with individually approved Flight Manuals. The majority of airplanes entered military service for which Military manuals (SFI SK50) were produced and used. Upon civil registration of Saab 91B, LFV (Formerly Board of Civil Aviation Sweden) issued a reference Flight Manual, FM 193. This manual makes reference to the military manual. The military use of the Safir is now ended and the SFI SK50 has no revision service and no legal meaning.

revision.
