SUBJECT:

Landing gear - Main landing gear - Replacement of Assistor Spring.

**BACKGROUND:** 

Assistor springs with the wire-formed end loop design, p/n AIR131330 & p/n AIR125132, have failed in service. Further, one known incident has been reported where the assistor spring cable (wire-rope) prevented the landing gear from locking in fully down position. The number of failures, along with

the known incident, indicates that there is an unsafe condition.

SAD 1-185, which mandates actions according to Service Bulletin SAAB

340-32-126 was released to restore the level of safety.

Due to discrepancies found in the design introduced by Service Bulletin

SAAB 340-32-126 further actions are required.
